Current situation

Timeline:

- January 2023: First session in train-the-trainer
- February 2023: Start training volunteers
- March 2023: launch project and local announcement in the try-out areas
- June 2023: First evaluation
- October 2023: Final rollout of the project (announcement new training sessions train-the-trainer – distribute script - ...)



Current situation

- Evaluation of the try-out lessons learned
- 2 professional teachers for the sessions train-the-trainer
- Installation of 3 working groups
 - Training
 - Communication
 - Target audiences
- Further development of support material
- New courses matching supply to demand 4th quarter of 2024 a minimum of 1 course trainthe-trainer
- Looking for collaboration with other stakeholders in cyber security



Current situation

- Trained approximately 60 teachers in train the trainer and 300 volunteers
- Active in 40 police districts and/or municipalities

Target: a rollout of the project in all the police districts or municipalities of Belgium at the first quarter of 2026
