..is a way to get everyone living and working in an area – to meet together with a knowledgeable organizer and discuss how the area can be made more secure and pleasant.



# Three meetings..

- Pre-meeting – introduction and identify areas
- Second meeting – the "on-foot" survey on routes in the area
- Concluding meeting - accountability



# The aim is

- a mutual exchange of ideas and viewpoints
- an opportunity to disseminate information
- discuss constructive ideas for changes.



# Things to consider in the process

- Surveys with different purposes
- Readiness to act
- Participants
- Statistics
- Discussion leader



# Longterm commitment

- The process needs to be established
- Not just a one time happening



# A way to collect data to the local needs analysis

- Both municipalities and local police districts use neighbourhood security survey to collect data, often in a joint venture.
- A common participant group is children and young people – Both in schools and in other public places
